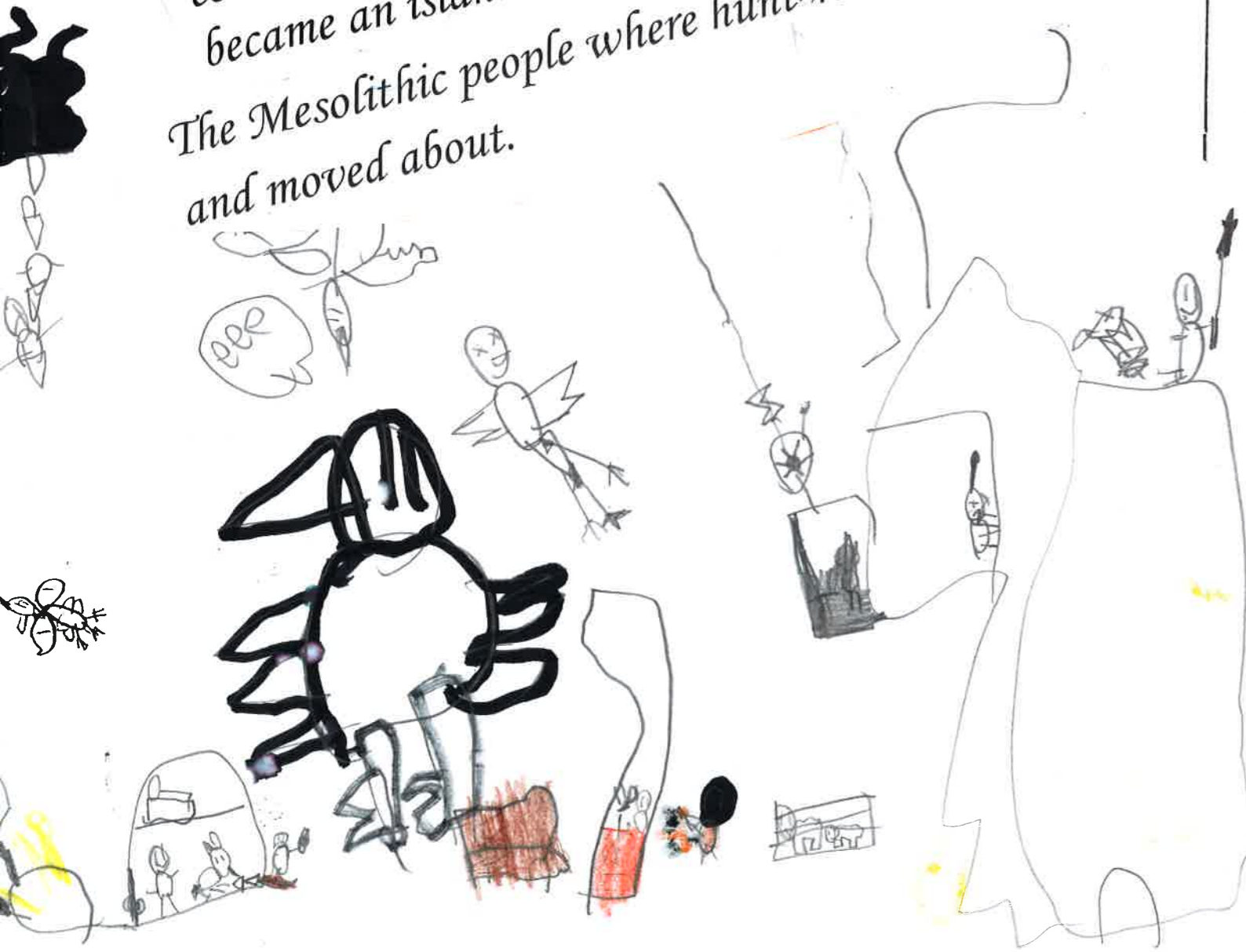

Mesolithic

The Mesolithic period began when the last ice sheet over Britain melted, the climate became warmer and large areas of woodland began to grow.

The sea level rose until Britain was no longer connected to mainland Europe and it therefore became an island on its own.

The Mesolithic people were hunters and gatherers and moved about.

Early pots were simple round-bottomed bowls made out of coils of clay.
